
The chicken translator is an application which translates from English to Latin. This program learns from your typing and improves as you type more frequently. This software works with a variety of programming languages, but the following are the most popular: C/C++, Perl, Python, Ruby and JavaScript. This program includes a dictionary for over 40 languages that you can use to translate into or out of English. It also lets you select a language that has already been translated so it can be used as an index for finding similar translations in other languages. In addition to all these features there is support for adding keyboard shortcuts and changing the screen color scheme or background image from black to white or any other color in between.

This software is also available in a Dutch version by the name of "KipTranslator". This application was written by John Tromp and the latest stable release is version 3.3.2, which was released on June 8, 2006. The source code and precompiled binaries for this application are available for download from the website.

John Tromp also wrote another language translator called "Translator X" that can translate to and from over 120 languages. It is available for Windows and Linux operating systems and includes support for adding keyboard shortcuts to your translation phrases as well as changing the color scheme or screen background image. In 2004 this program won the Deloitte Technology Fast 50, a contest that honors those companies which have experienced the fastest growth over a five-year period. In 2006 the "Chicken Systems Translator" was inducted into the Silicon Valley Engineering Hall of Fame along with John Tromp, its creator. In 2006, "PC Magazine" gave the Chicken Systems Translator an award for being one of the best language translation programs available. In 2009 it received another PC Magazine award for being one of their top 5 language translation applications.

Chicken Systems Translator was also used to create an English - Arabic Dictionary by Rida Taysir that was used along with his book *Coping with Arabic: A Self-Teaching Guide*. The dictionary contains over 2000 words and phrases for learning Arabic.
